Overview

Henri Matisse was born in a town in Northern France with little sun and natural light. But he grew up with colors. Surrounded by colorful plates painted by his mother and pigeons whose colors changed when they moved, Matisse continued to love and paint his childhood memory throughout his life. After the story about Matisse, the students will be asked to decorate a blank plate with colorful pieces already cut out for them. While the students are concentrated at their projects.
